Restricting Visitors

If you are able to come alone, please do so. If you require a support person to be present at your visit we will be allowing ONE visitor per patient, and NO children.



Screening and Testing

- All patients will be pre-screened for COVID-19 before their visit.
- Temperature checks will be done upon entry to our building.
- Those with symptoms will be evaluated in a safe, dedicated area.



Keeping it Clean and Safe

- Mandatory Masks for staff, patients and visitors.
- Hand Sanitizers: We clean our hands before and after we see you. You should clean yours when you enter and exit our building.
- **Common Areas:** Extensive cleaning of waiting rooms, lobbies and restrooms, including most-touched surfaces.
- **Exam Rooms:** These are properly cleaned and disinfected between each patient.
