

The Thriving After Cancer Survivorship Clinic provides comprehensive care for survivors of childhood and adult cancers. Our multidisciplinary team is focused on the medical and emotional impact of cancer and its treatment.

Our goal is to help you attain the best quality of life. The survivorship clinic teaches you about the potential late side effects of your treatment. It also explains what you should be doing to maintain and improve your health.



Our Team Approach

Our team includes a nurse practitioner, oncologist, internist, social worker, registered dietitian, nurse navigator, neurologist and psychiatrist. Together, we provide comprehensive care to cancer survivors. We focus on:

- Education
- Symptom Management

Survivorship Education

At the end of the visit you will receive a survivorship care plan, which includes:

- A summary of your treatment
- An outline of the potential late effects of your treatment
- Nutrition and physical activity recommendations
- Cancer screening recommendations

Our clinic provides you with medical services, including a comprehensive physical exam, but your care doesn't stop there. We also connect you with:

- Physical therapists and physical activity programs
- Emotional support and therapy
- Registered dieticians
- Educational events
- Resources for cancer survivors
